The purpose of the South Carolina Autism Society is to enable all individuals in South Carolina with autism spectrum disorders to reach their maximum potential. It does this by providing information, referrals, and support for people with autism spectrum disorders, their families and professionals, and strongly advocates for state and federal legislation to provide the services necessary for persons with autism.

**Submission Process:** Submit an abstract describing the proposal. Generally an abstract should be no more than 600 words. However, this is not set in stone. Be specific enough for reviewers to be able to grasp the nature of the program, its scope, and the planning done in preparation. Submit (a) one copy of the 300-600 word proposal, (b) one copy of the form on the next page, (c) a cover sheet and (d) disk containing the proposal and coversheet. The cover sheet should include the title, a 25-40 word session description, and the names of all presenters with addresses, phone numbers, e-mail, employers, and respective roles (*e.g.* session leader, presenter, etc.). Please do not use abbreviations. Applications may be e-mailed with all of the required information to [scas@scautism.org](mailto:scas@scautism.org). Please send all material to South Carolina Autism Society, 806 12th Street, West Columbia, SC 29169. Material is due by June 1, 2007. **Presentation Formats:** Lecture Sessions—limited to one hour

**Selection Process:** The Conference Planning Committee will be responsible for selection of all presentation.
